# Réglement de course

## Contest Wingfoil

### 1. Organization

The contest Wingfoil is a race accredited by the French Sailing Federation (FFV) organized by the SEML Saint Jean Activités on Sunday August 23rd 2020 as part of Vendée Gliss Event.

1.1 The organization commits to respect an obligation of means to assure the security within the realms of possibility and holds attention on the impossibility of commitment to an obligation of results.

1.2 In case of force majeure (natural disaster, strike, dangerous weather...) the race would be cancelled or postponed.

1.3 The organization signed up for an organizer public liability insurance in compliance with the legislation in effect.

1.4 The competitors accept without restriction the use by the organization of all images and actions, photographed, shot and/or sound recording made during the length of time of the event. Each participant accepts without restriction to be flown over, photographed and filmed by a drone.

1.5 The organization is attached to the absolute respect of people, goods and environment and will be able to remove irrevocably every participant flouting its values of the environment.

1.6 Every enrolment is worth the acceptance of this present regulation.

### 2. Practical rules

2.1 Races will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

### 3. Conditions of admission and enrolments

3.1 Enrolments are open from April 6th 2020. **The enrolment's deadline is fixed on August 20th 2020**

3.2 The amount of registration is 30€ per personne +15€ for rent a wing. No refund of the amount of the registration will be made in case of withdrawal of a competitor.

3.3 Competitors holding an FFVoile licence must present at the time of registration: -their Club licence mentioning «competition» valid or their ClubFFVoile licence mentioning «membership» or «practice» accompanied by a medical certificate of non-contraindication to the practice of sailing in competition dating less than one year or the possibility to subscribe to a daily licence.

3.4 For the minors, the legal representative will have to sign a parental permission

3.5 Every competitor attest to be able to swim.

3.6 Every competitor may be prohibited to not continue the race for an incompetence reason

3.7 The numbered bib of the organization must be worn over any other clothing.

3.8. Foreign competitors who do not hold an FFVoile licence must present at the time of registration a proof of membership of a National Authority member of World Sailing or/and a proof of a valid civil liability insurance, a medical certificate of no contraindication to the practice of sailing in competition dating from less than one year ago.

3.9 The race is open to all Wingfoil supports.

## 4. Official program

Race day :

Sunday August 23rd

The departures will be in pools of 8 maximum, only the first two will be qualified. The competition will start with the initiated riders who have mastered the support, the same system as the qualifications will be set up. Several heats may take place depending on the number of participants and the wind.

## 5. Route, Race Committee, Complaints, Ranking

5.1 Route : slalom downwind in W (three jibes with 3 jibes). The start is in the water near the beach, with a crosswind between two buoys. In case of a stolen start, the offender(s) are disqualified for the race, and the racers recalled for a new start. The location of the race area is defined in front of Plage des Oiseaux

5.2 Race instructions will be posted on the day of the race as well as the starting procedure.

5.3 Race Committee

If possible, the Race Committee is composed of a federal delegate designated by FFV, an organization supervisor, a security supervisor (race director), a representative of men competitors and a representative of women competitors.

5.4 Complaints

any complaints must be done imperatively in writing to the Race Committee or Race Direction, in a period of fifteen minutes after the posting of provisional results. The hour indicated on the results' posting determinate the beginning of the period

5.5 Ranking : Prize giving for 3 first

## 6. Sécurité

6.1 The decision of a competitor to take part in a race or to remain in the race is his sole responsibility (RCV 4). Consequently, by agreeing to take part in the race or to stay in the race, the competitor releases the organisation from any responsibility in case of damage (material and/or physical).

6.2 The weather conditions can lead to a modification of the route. The interventions and route's modifications for security reasons don't lead to any ranking's readjustment.

6.6 Abandonment : Any abandonment must be immediately informed to an organization member.

6.8 Obligatory equipment :

6.8.1 A helmet with et le impact vest are obligatory

6.8.2 In case of bad weather, the race director reserves the right to impose the wearing of a neoprene wetsuit.

6.8.3 Competitors must ensure that their number on the bib is clearly visible at all times.

## 7. Penalties

La RCV 44.1 is modified so that the two-lap penalty is replaced by the one-lap penalty.
